

# Town of Belvidere

## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-2

For Town Electors to Authorize the Town Board to Exceed State Spending Limits on Town Roads in 2018

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin State Statutes limit towns from spending more than \$5,000 per mile of road during the course of a calendar year; and

**WHEREAS**, this limit includes the cost of all aspects of road repair and maintenance, including snowplowing, filling potholes, and re-surfacing; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Belvidere has about 31 miles of road, which limits the spending on its roads to no more than \$155,000 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Statute hasn't been updated in decades to account for inflation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the residents of the Town of Belvidere do hereby authorize the Belvidere Town Board to spend up to \$400,000 on Town roads in calendar year 2018, if the Town Board believes it is in the best interest of the Town to do so.




